As always, there is a large need for volunteers to work on all aspects of the sale: set up (Thursday, Friday & Saturday morning), staffing the sale table and room monitoring during the sale, and finally, clean up on Sunday at 4 p.m. If you can spare an hour or two, contact the FOL Volunteer Coordinator, Jen Merrill, volunteers@olympiafriends.com. She still has openings at most times. Volunteer time and expertise are critical for the success of the sale.


