#### Timberland Regional Libraries Board of Trustees Meeting

Nationwide, all libraries are changing and this is the time to keep abreast of what is happening with events occurring in the Timberland Library District. The Board of Trustees meets the second Wednesday of every month at the Administrative Service Center in Tumwater or one of the local libraries. *On January 9, 2019 they will be meeting at 5:30 p.m. in the Administrative Service Center 415 Tumwater Boule-vard SW, Tumwater, WA. The Public is encouraged to attend.* 

The Timberland District was created in 1968 and funded for the most part by money generated by Washington State Forest Lands. That money dried up in the early 1980s precipitating a crisis of cutting staff and closing libraries.

Timberland became part of the Junior Taxing district receiving money from property taxes. This worked well for more than 20 years, but no longer does the money generated cover expenses. Now more than ever in the digital age our libraries serve as an important part of our communities. 
