New Furniture for the Library

Frequent visitors to the Olympia Library may have noticed the gradual changes that have taken place over the last few years. The goal is to remake the space for the way libraries are used now and in the future. A high priority is to give patrons space to recharge and use their computers. Every corner needs to be used and one of the first additions is two high tables where there use to be filing cabinets under the windows at the front of the building. The two power bars (standing tables with electrical connections) were designed and built by local woodworker, J. T. Scott, using solid white oak with a durable finish.

This beautiful and useful addition to the Olympia Library was made possible by the ongoing work of Friends of the Olympia Library volunteers.
