Changes Ahead for the Friends of the Olympia Library

In the two months following Thanksgiving, the Olympia Timberland Library will be closed for renovations. This will mean some adjustments in the way the FOL will be handling book donations and sales. ***No donations will be accepted from November 22, 2019, to February 2, 2020.*** If the donations can't be held until February, the Tumwater Library and Lacey Library Friends groups can take them. The Lacey Friends are currently collecting books for Merritt Manor, the new affordable house complex on Martin Way.

When the Library reopens, the FOL ongoing sale will occupy the whole wall to the right of the youth services office.

More Changes to Look For--

During the more than two months most of the Olympia Library will be closed, the meeting room *will be open* for patrons to pick up holds and return borrowed materials. Enter through the door nearest the corner of Adams Street and 9th Avenue.

The Olympia Staff will also continue to offer programs at other venues. Page Turners, for instance will be meeting at the Lacey Library, the Film Club at Three Magnets Brewing, Teen Book Club at Browsers Books, and Reading Explorers at the Lacey Library. The Big Red Cart

The red book cart filled with Holiday books and media is still in the library's atrium and is refreshed daily with new items to help celebrate the season, including, story books for children, cookbooks, craft books and fiction.

Nearby, the ongoing book sale is filled with many books, CDs and DVDs in great condition and suitable for gifting. New items are added daily with a broad selection of fiction, nonfiction, biographies, histories, humor, poetry, small treasures, craft, gardening and cookbooks. Young Adult books are on a separate cart near the FOL information slat board. The children's book cart remains below the sale cash box.
