Saturdays usually find the parking lot filled with cars and people arriving for Family Storytime, to check out books and media or to use the many public internet computers. During the lockdown the only service still available is the public rest rooms, a historically provided library amenity since 1914. Now in the form of porta potties provided by the city.

I hope you and your family and friends are well during this difficult time. I wanted to let you know that I have accepted a 3-month appointment as Interim District Manager, Adult Services working out of the TRL Administrative Service Center where I will be in charge of a variety of district level projects and supervise the managers of the 6 Lewis County branches.

My first day is April 1st (though I will remain working from home like the rest of TRL staff). I will still be very available and working closely with Olympia's staff if any issues arise.

During my absence, Chris Chrzan will be serving as the Interim Library Manager for the Olympia Branch.

- New tentative reopening to the public is May 11th (this date could change)
- We are currently working on a reopening plan which may include not all branches reopening at the same time, social distancing requirement, reduced hours, and other restrictions
- The FOL Book Sale (May 30 & 31) has to be cancelled. All programs, outreach and meeting room bookings are cancelled through the end of June. The next sale is scheduled September 13-14.
- Unknown date for when volunteers can come back to work in the building.
- Also unknown is when we can resume accepting donations.

These are challenging times and I appreciate your understanding as we navigate when and how to reopen and keep staff, patrons, and our wonderful volunteers as safe as possible.
