However, citing the need to reduce congestion, Timberland Regional Library facilities management has concluded that the cart needed to be removed and even a smaller one-sided cart, similar to one used before the refresh, is unacceptable.

The free materials were very popular with patrons looking for a good read or material for an art project. Heading out of town? A free book can be discarded guilt free when finished. Love a freebie? The free cart was the place to go for magazines and mass market paperbacks.

Also, gone from the library are the Courtesy shelves of mass market paperback books supplied by the FOL. These were also designed out of the library at the last remodel.
