
### **Summer Reading Program a Great Success**

# Volunteering for the Friends of the Olympia Library from Rob Harper

One part of the book sorting I enjoy is the discovery of a document or book about an unexpected subject or topic. Such was the case on my July 1 volunteer day when I reached for a long thin brochure at the bottom of a box new donations. The document was an illustrated guide to a 1928 art exhibit in Shanghai. Printed in English, much of the brochure featured full page ads for investment banks, commercial real estate firms and luxury goods. Featured art work was towards the end of the brochure and were subjects seemly directed towards a Westernized audience, many of whom probably lived in Shanghai's autonomous expatriate enclave which arose from centuries of foreign domination in China. While the brochure will be considered for eBay listing, it made me curious to learn more about the mixture of cultures and social development in pre-World War II China.
