Friends of the Olympia Library volunteers this month completed another step in the readjustment to the new space allotted to them in the Olympia Library. Adjusting to the new space dubbed the Book Store has been hard. The sale space is about the same, although the media kiosk and Last Chance cart have been eliminated, but the space available now to accept, sort, store and price the donations is much more compact and public.


Initially it was thought book carts could be used to replace the large black bin used to accept donations. This worked, sort of, but not very well, so it was finally decided to get another, smaller bin. This new one is silver and has a floating floor that rises for easy access by all of our volunteers. It is just inside to the right of the Book Store's door and takes up a bit less space than the carts and holds more books and media. Thank you, Mary Condon and Linda Neary, for assembling and staging the bin.

FOL at the Olympia-Lacey Centennial Train Station

How did it happen that you can find free books at the train station? It all began about 17 years ago when Centennial Station volunteer Bobbe decided the best use of her late son Corke's huge book collection was to put them in the waiting room for travelers to read on their journeys. She placed them on the wide window sills for easy browsing and they were an instant hit. After several years and Covid, the Friends of the Olympia Library started stocking the shelves with books left over from its book sales. From the window sills, the collection moved to the old pay phone shelf and now finally to a larger, proper book shelf and a repurposed magazine rack for children's materials. Both are very popular and are restocked often by FOL volunteers Danielle Green and Rose Jetter.
