New Volunteer Handbook Approved

The Friends of the Olympia Library Organizing Committee, of Robin Ivey-Black, Sue Goldstein, Rose Jetter, Mary lee Tatro and Rob Harper, has been very busy since the move last spring to our new, more compact space. The move changed drastically the way donated books and media had to be sorted, stored and displayed. The new space, combined with many changes and new volunteers, in turn required a more efficient way to communicate as well as a process and flow manual.

Sue and Rose started the ball rolling creating a rough draft, using much of the text from Rose's training handouts. Other language came from members of the Committee. In a couple of cases, people who do a specific procedure were contacted to confirm or clarify the procedure.

The rough draft then was sent to the other members of the committee and to the FOL Board for their input. After several revisions and editing by Sue Goldstein, the Volunteer Handbook was finished and approved in late September, and copies of this very useful document now reside in the FOL sorting space.
